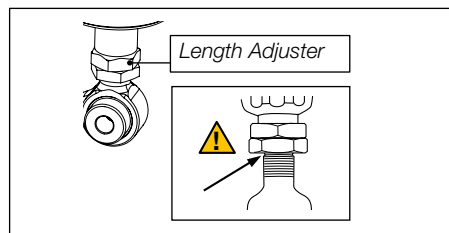


# ADJUSTMENTS

# SET-UP DATA

## Recommended set-up

Rebound ..... 12clicks  
 Compression ..... 13clicks  
 Spring Preload..... 21mm

## Shock absorber data

Length..... 325 <sup>+12</sup>/<sub>0</sub>mm  
 Stroke ..... 62mm

# MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

## ⚠ Warning!

*It is advisable to have an Öhlins dealer install the shock absorber/front fork/steering damper.*

## ⚠ Warning!

*If working on a raised vehicle, ensure it is securely supported so that it will not tip.*

## 👁 Note!

*Before mounting this product clean the vehicle thoroughly.*

## 👁 Note!

*When working on this product, always see the Vehicle Service Manual for vehicle specific procedures and important data.*

- 1 Remove seat, side covers, battery and battery holder.
- 2 Loosen the electrical panel on the left side.
- 3 Remove the mounting screw for the expansion vessel.
- 4 Remove the damping adjustment rod.
- 5 Loosen the air filling hose.
- 6 Remove the upper mounting bolt.
- 7 Remove the bolt that connects the front and rear link.
- 8 Remove the lower mounting bolt.
- 9 Remove the original shock absorber.
- 10 Mount the Öhlins Shock absorber. Mount it from below, mount the reservoir first.
- 11

Mount the upper mounting bolt.

## 12

Mount the bolt that connects the front and rear links. Ensure that the bearings are greased. Ensure that seals are not damaged.

## 13

Lift the swing arm slightly. Mount the lower mounting screw and the washer and nut provided in the kit.

## 14

Tighten the upper and lower mounting bolts. Tighten the bolt that connects the rear and front links.

## 15

Lead the hose according to figure.

## 16

Remount the electrical panel, expansion vessel, battery holder, battery, side covers and seat.

## 👁 Note!

*Lower the vehicle so that the suspension is slightly compressed before tightening the screws.*

## 👉 Caution!

*Ensure that all screws are tightened to the correct torque and that nothing fouls or restricts movement of the shock absorber/front fork/steering damper when the suspension is fully compressed or extended.*
